

Ziya September 2025 Update

Overview:

In September, we crossed **KES 16.3M** in total disbursements and launched our long-awaited Android app on the Play Store. We deepened efficiency, scaled trust, and continued proving that you can do finance differently — without interest, without CAC, and without friction.

1. Key Achievements

Loan & User Metrics

- 398 new loans issued in September \rightarrow 3,353 total loans to date
- **KES 2.3M disbursed** in September (16% MoM growth)
- KES 16.3M total capital disbursed
- 99.5% repayment rate strongest month so far
- 871 MSMEs served to date → 46 new users onboarded in September
- Capital velocity now at 4.5X, fully circulating from just KES 3.5M in seed capital
- KES 48,100 in subscription revenue (slightly lower due to app migration)

Technology & Platform Progress

- Ziya Android app officially launched on Google Play
- Group leaders already migrated; full MSME migration continues in October
- Web and mobile platform enhancements to reduce onboarding time & friction
- Improved website navigation and published impact reports for transparency
- Biggest user concern: delays in capital renewal post-repayment
 - Optimization efforts now underway to reduce wait times for top-up loans

Customer Experience & Support

- Call and SMS flows performing well & Continued excellent feedback from users
- Launched internal **efficiency initiative** to automate loan top-up approvals
- Customer onboarding now guided by new playbook + app flow

Ecosystem Engagement

- Participated in two Mombasa-based ecosystem workshops:
 - Westerwelle Startup Haus
 - IOMee by Red Cross
- Strengthened positioning as the working capital partner for CBOs, ROSCAs, and youth-led economic groups, especially in the blue economy and sustainable finance

2. Focus for October

- Cross 1,000 MSMEs served
- Finalize migration of all groups to the Ziya app
- Cut capital renewal wait times by 50%
- Launch storytelling campaigns from real MSME journeys
- Explore automated scoring for dynamic loan tiers
- Begin expansion feasibility study into two new counties
